



Dear Parents/carers,

We look forward to welcoming you and your child back to school tomorrow (Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> August 2021).

Below are a few reminders to help you;

- Children are to be dropped off between 8.45am and 8.55am and collected at 3.15pm. Please check your parent/child leaflet for details of your child's drop off/collection point.
- New Reception starters should arrive for 9am and will be collected at 1pm for the first three days and then will follow the above times from Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> August.
- Clarke Street and Checketts Road entrances will be open this year.
- Only one parent to drop off children to help minimise the numbers on site.
- Please drop your child to their class teacher and leave the site as quickly as possible – help us to avoid unnecessary gatherings.
- Face coverings are no longer required on site but we recommend them at potentially crowded times such as drop off and collection.
- If you are collecting your child from the main playground please wait away from the school building and towards the field/ballcourt side of the playground.
- We will be serving school dinners from Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> August.
- Please do not send your child to school if they are displaying COVID symptoms or are unwell. If they are symptomatic they should get a PCR test and isolate until they receive their result.
- If your child tests positive themselves, they must self-isolate for 10 days.
- Children no longer need to self-isolate if they are a **close contact** of a positive COVID case, this includes if a member of their household has tested positive. They are however recommended to take a PCR test but can continue to attend school whilst awaiting their result.
- We are no longer separating children into year group bubbles, but we will continue to promote good hand and respiratory hygiene, maintain good ventilation and enhanced cleaning procedures of the school building.
