Face Coverings

The Local Authority are **now actively urging parents to wear a face-covering when dropping off and picking up children from school**. The wearing of face coverings in congested areas and where individuals are unable to consistently maintain social distancing is seen as an effective measure to reduce the spread of the virus.

We would like to remind parents that children should not be wearing any hoodies as part of the school uniform or the PE kit.
